





Different body language for different culture groups


Story of Korean Pastor at the Office Story of feet dandling down






Why is the written word still important?






# Type of Communication Barriers at All Stages

■ Too lengthy, disorganized, erroneous message	Message
Poor verbal and body language	Message
Lack of Self-Confidence	Source
Lack of Enthusiasm	Source / Receiver
<ul> <li>Discrimination</li> </ul>	Source / Receiver
Disagreement between verbal and non-verbal messages	Message
Negative Self Image	Source
<ul> <li>Lack of Feedback</li> </ul>	Receiver
<ul> <li>Language and Vocabulary Level</li> </ul>	Source / Receiver
Selective Perception	Receiver
<ul> <li>Lack of Interest in the Topic/Subject</li> </ul>	Receiver
■ Voice quality / Venue / Effect of Noise	Channel
